Wood River Avenue, with the recital of the Pledge of Allegiance. The Clerk called the roll and reported that the following members were:

#### **CITIZENS COMMENTS:**

Mary Roberts stated that the Wood River Memorial Day Service at the Roundhouse this past Monday, May 27, 2024, was a fitting tribute to our men and women who put on the uniform to serve our Country and died for our freedom. Ms. Roberts thanked Mayor Tom Stalcup for allowing her to chair the committee to honor these heroes. Ms. Roberts thanked Councilman Jeremy Plank for being the Emcee, and Councilman Ayres and Councilman Dettmers for attending the service. She also thanked the Marine Corps Ladies Auxiliary Unit 488 Chaplain/Judge Advocate, Lola Cochran, and Marine Veteran Daphine Kappos for reading the names on the Memorial and chiming the bell after each name in honor of each hero. She thanked Chris Apps the St. Louis Bagpiper for

playing "Scotland the Brave", and "Amazing Grace", and leading the community in songs from Central Park to the Roundhouse. She also thanked BSA Troop 777 from Rosewood Heights for posting and retiring the colors and leading the Pledge of Allegiance, and Marissa Jones, who is a 2024 Alton High School Graduate, ROTC, and Army National Guard for singing the National Anthem. She thanked Jeffrey Sanders, an Army Veteran and a student at the Illinois School of Ministry for the Invocation and Benediction, and William Steiner, an EAWR High School Junior, for playing TAPS. She then thanked Girl Scout Troop 325 for performing the Missing Man Table Presentation, the guest speaker, CSM Phillip J. Barber, who is State Command Sergeant Major, Illinois Army National Guard, and the Alton VFW Post 1308 for the "21 Gun Salute". Ms. Roberts thanked her committee, Sara Lewis Sladek, Vicki Parsons, and Rosalie Huebener. She also thanked Jeff Gray, Director of Parks and Recreation Pat Minogue, and City Clerk Danielle Sneed for all their assistance. She thanked Kenny Kutter for the Flag Display and the Marine Corps Ladies Auxiliary Unit 488 for providing refreshments and water. Ms. Roberts gave a special thank you to the Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, Marissa Jones, and William Steiner for giving their time so freely to be a part of the service. She thanked all those who came out to honor and remember our special heroes of Wood River. Veterans Day Service will be held on Monday, November 11, 2024, at 4:00 p.m. at the East Alton Wood River High School Memorial Gymnasium, and 20 quilts of valor will be given to our Veterans.

Mayor Stalcup stated that the Memorial Day Service was outstanding and thanked Ms. Roberts for bringing Memorial Day forward.

#### CITY OFFICIAL COMMENTS:

Mayor Stalcup stated that starting Thursday, June 6, 2024, and every Thursday from 3:00 p.m. to dusk, the Farmers Market will be open in the parking lot of Madison Avenue and First Street. On Friday, June 14, 2024, at 7:00 p.m. the Annual Bike Ramble will start at Central Park. The cost to enter is \$3.00 per individual and \$6.00 for families. Immediately following the Bike Ramble will be a movie in the park, featuring the "Wizard of Oz". On Sunday, July 14, 2024, the Annual Ice Cream Social will be held at Central Park from 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. The Spring/Summer edition of the Pipeline should be in mailboxes this week.

Mayor Stalcup asked Kristen Burns to come forward. Ms. Burns stated that Thursday, June 6, 2024, will be this season's first Farmers Market Downtown. There will be live music playing from various artists and food vendors. Rachel & Co. Coffee House will be open late along with some other downtown businesses. Ferguson Street Burger Bar will be doing a Thursday night special. There are currently 28 vendors that have registered for the entire year and the goal is to have at least 30 vendors. There will be a movie night in the park after the Bike Ramble, on Friday, June 14, 2024, sponsored by First Mid Bank & Trust. There will be popcorn and Kona Ice. The next "What's Up Downtown" meeting is scheduled for Thursday, June 20, 2024, at the Wood River Library beginning at 6:30 p.m. to discuss everything happening in downtown Wood River. Main Street affiliates will be taking pictures of Downtown Wood River and taking measurements because they are working on the City's inventory for Downtown. Main Street affiliates will also block out the Downtown area and use a software program that will give more information about the buildings including historical checking of the buildings as they move forward to hopefully get some historic preservation funds for the City as well as other projects.

Councilman Dettmers stated that he has spoken to Mayor Stalcup and Chief Stahlhut about the power outages that have been happening recently. There have been four power outages since March, including the one that occurred on Monday, June 3, 2024. Councilman Dettmers stated that it prompted him to inquire about the City's emergency preparedness. People have been asking him why there have been so many power outages in Wood River. He stated he understands that the City

does not control the power. The outages have impacted not only the electrical but also the internet service in Kendall Hill. He then asked Chief Stahlhut to explain where the City currently is with the Emergency Operations Manual.

Chief Stahlhut stated that the Fire Department is currently identifying who the City will use as a third party to assist in the revisions of the Emergency Operations Manual. The Manual is an extremely large document that encompasses all departments, the Library, and the pipelines from the industries surrounding the City. Power outages are a part of the Emergency Operations Manual and identifying warming centers and cooling centers. If there is an extensive power outage, the City must consider establishing transportation for residents to get to other locations. The Emergency Operations Manual has not been updated recently and is due for revisions.

Councilman Dettmers responded that he is eager to learn what the Fire Department comes up with after the Emergency Operations Manual has been reviewed.

Discussion ensued regarding the safety concerns when experiencing power outages and other emergencies, for example, the incident that happened at the refinery a couple of years ago. Chief Stahlhut explained that The Hazard Mitigation Plan for Madison County is also under review at this time, which is completed every five years and is included in the City's Emergency Operations Manual.

Councilman Ayres stated that the Walmart Memorial Day Service was apropos. He thanked Walmart for putting together the Ceremony.

Mayor Stalcup thanked Julia Duckles from Wood River Walmart who has been conducting the Memorial Day Service for 10 to 12 years.

Discussion ensued regarding how great the Walmart Memorial Day Service was and how the woman who sang the National Anthem did a beautiful job.

# ORDINANCE NO. 2899: AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A LEASE OF LAND BETWEEN THE CITY OF WOOD RIVER AND KAMADULSKI EXCAVATING AND GRADING CO., INC.:

Councilman Ayres moved to approve an ordinance authorizing the execution of a lease of land between the City of Wood River and Kamadulski Excavating and Grading Co., Inc., as submitted by the Director of Public Services, seconded by Councilman Dettmers

Councilman Dettmers stated that he needed clarification regarding the terms of the lease. It states that the City has the authority to execute leases with tenants for terms not to exceed two years and upon authority granted by the City Council, the City Manager need not obtain the City Council's approval to renew the lease going forward, so long as all leases are substantially in the form of the exhibit; and for terms not exceeding two years. Councilman Dettmers then stated that the lease does not state that the City Manager has the right to extend it for a two-year period, it does not restrict it at all. He then asked if the City Manager has the authority to renew the lease automatically if the project is not done by 2027.

City Attorney Mike McGinley replied in the affirmative and stated that the purpose of that statute is efficiency. With short-term leases, anything less than two years would allow the City Manager to renew the lease going forward. If the terms do not change on the lease, the City Council does not need to review it every year before it is renewed.

The project is expected to be completed before the end of 2027 and at the end of 2025, the City Manager can renew it for another two years as long as the terms do not change.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY CODE 90-7, TITLE VII: TRAFFIC CODE, CHAPTER 71: PARKING REGULATIONS, SECTION 71.26 MUNICIPAL PARKING LOTS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Wood River desires to amend ordinance, Section 71.26 regarding Parking Regulations as part of Title VII, Chapter 71 of the Municipal Code of the City of Wood River, namely Municipal Parking Lots; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Wood River has determined that it becomes necessary to amend ordinances from time to time.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOOD RIVER, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter 71: Parking Regulations be amended as follows:

#### 71.26 MUNICIPAL PARKING LOTS.

- (A) The public parking lot adjacent to the Wood River Public Swimming Pool Recreation Center and Round House is hereby designated as a one-way drive and the following regulations shall apply:
  - (1) All traffic into such parking lot shall enter only from Whitelaw Avenue at the extreme northern end of said parking lot.
  - (2) Traffic exiting from said parking lot shall exit onto Eaton Avenue at the extreme southerly end of said parking lot; except that the exit for southbound traffic from the parking lot onto Whitelaw Avenue shall be at the Round House.
  - (3) No person shall operate any motor vehicle upon said public parking lot except in a southerly direction nor shall any person enter or exit into or from said parking lot at any spot other than as designated herein.
  - (4) The parking spaces identified as being reserved for the handicapped and city vehicles are at all times reserved for this designated purpose. The Police Chief is hereby authorized to direct the towing and impoundment of vehicles parked in violation of this section. (Ord. 88-2, passed 6-6-88) ('60 Code, Ch. X, § 8.20)
- Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
- Section 3. That in all other respects Ordinance 90-7, the City Code, shall remain in full force and effect.

<u>Section 4.</u> This ordinance shall be in full force and effect following its passage and publication in accordance with law.

### ORDINANCE VACATING A CUL DE SAC LOCATED IN GRAND VIEW HILLS SUBDIVISION, CITY OF WOOD RIVER, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the City of Wood River, Madison County, Illinois (hereinafter "City"), is a non-home rule municipality duly established, existing and operating in accordance with the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code (Section 5/1-1-1 et seq. of Chapter 65 of the Illinois Compiled Statutes); and

WHEREAS, upon information and belief, Grand View Hills Subdivision ("Grand View") was Final Platted in approximately 2007 for residential development; and

WHEREAS, upon information and belief, the developers of Grand View discovered a pipeline in approximately 2022 that prevented construction of Grand View according to the original final plat; and

WHEREAS, upon information and belief, the developers of Grand View have been forced to re-plat Grand View to accommodate the newly discovery pipe-line, and have reduced the number of lots from four to three in the area of the cul de sac shown on the 2007 plat (See Final Plat, Grand View Hills, Plat 2, City of Wood River, Madison County, Illinois attached hereto as **Exhibit A**; hereinafter "Final Plat 2"); and

WHEREAS, upon information and belief, City accepted the cul de sac as part of the 2007 Grand View Final Plat, City currently owns and controls the cul de sac shown on the 2007 Grand View Final Plat, and the legal description of the cul de sac is stated below:



# ORDINANCE DECLARING PERSONAL PROPERTY OF THE CITY OF WOOD RIVER SURPLUS AND AUTHORIZING ITS SALE, TRADE IN, AND/OR DISPOSAL, SPECIFICALLY A TRUCK, VIN# 05023381

WHEREAS, the City of Wood River, Madison County, Illinois (hereinafter "City"), is a non-home rule municipality duly established, existing and operating in accordance with the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code (Section 5/1-1-1 et seq. of Chapter 65 of the Illinois Compiled Statutes); and

WHEREAS, 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4 provides that whenever a municipality in the state of Illinois owns any personal property which, in the opinion of a simple majority of the corporate authorities then holding office, is no longer necessary or useful to, or in the best interests of the municipality to keep, a majority of the corporate authorities at any regular or special meeting called for that purpose, may: (1) by Ordinance authorize the sale of such personal property in whatever manner they designate with or without advertising the sale; or (2) may authorize any municipal officer to convert that personal property to the use of the City; or (3) may authorize any municipal officer to convey or turn in any specified article of personal property as part payment on a new purchase of any similar article; and

### **Agreement**



This Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into this \_\_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_\_\_, 2024 ("Effective Date"), by and between ("SPONSOR") and City of Wood River("OWNER"). OWNER and/or SPONSOR may each be referred to individually as a "Party" or collectively as the "Parties".

WHEREAS, OWNER has built the Wood River Recreation Center which will include the amenities hereinafter described; and

NOW, THERFORE, in consideration of the promises in this Agreement and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Parties agree as follows:

### **EXCLUSIVITY, DESIGNATION AND RIGHTS TO MARKS**

SPONSOR will be an official sponsor of the Wood River Recreation Center and will have the right to utilize the
official marks and logos of the Wood River Recreation Center to designate itself as a sponsor of this venue in
the following categories:

### LANDMARK – WALKING TRACK PARTNER

- 1. SPONSOR will receive one (1) 12' X 3.5' banner ad on the walking track of the Wood River Recreation Center.
  - a.) OWNER will be responsible for the upkeep of the Wood River Recreation Center. SPONSOR has no responsibility for, and shall not be held responsible for, any aspects related to the day-to-day operation, control, or ownership of the Wood River Recreation Center, including but not limited to Wood River Recreation Center repairs and maintenance.
  - b.) OWNER and SPONSOR shall mutually agree upon signage. OWNER will be responsible for the initial costs of production or procurement and installation of such signage, and also responsible for the reasonable maintenance thereof.

### MEDIA, DIGITAL, SOCIAL, AND ONSITE MARKETING

1. SPONSOR and OWNER will mutually agree upon in writing and disseminate a social media post and/or schedule a press conference announcing the partnership solely between SPONSOR and OWNER.

### TERM AND INVESTMENT

The Term of this Agreement will be for five (5) years.

- 1. SPONSOR will pay OWNER as follows for the partnership to the Wood River Recreation Center via the following monetary amounts, excluding any sales tax that might be applicable:
  - i. Year 1 (2024 2025) = \$5,000.00
  - ii. Year 2 (2025 2026) = \$5,000.00
  - iii. Year 3 (2026 2027) = \$5,000.00
  - iv. Year 4 (2027 2028) = \$5,000.00
  - v. Year 5(2029 2030) = \$5,000.00

- 2. Payments will be due on an annual basis and are due and payable at the beginning of each contract year unless one time payment is paid.
  - i. 1st payment due on or before July 1, 2024
  - ii. 2nd payment not due until the 1-year anniversary of signage installation date
- 3. OWNER shall provide SPONSOR with an invoice for each annual installment no later than forty-five days prior to the due date thereof. Annual payments will be in default if not received by OWNER within fifteen days of the due date thereof.
- 4. Owner shall be solely responsible for its own fees and expenses incurred as a result of its performance under this Agreement, unless otherwise previously agreed to by SPONSOR in writing.

### **TERMINATION**

- SPONSOR may, in its sole discretion, terminate this Agreement by written notice to OWNER if: (a) OWNER
  ceases to own or operate the Wood River Recreation Center or the location of the Wood River Recreation
  Center changes; or (b) OWNER misrepresents, misappropriates or misuses the name or Marks (as defined
  below) of SPONSOR.
- 2. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in this Agreement, in no event shall a Party be liable to the other Party for any consequential, special, indirect, incidental, punitive, exemplary, or similar damages (including damages for loss of use, business, or profit) that the other Party suffers in connection with this Agreement, regardless whether such action is based on contract, tort, or any other legal theory and whether such Party has been advised of the possibility of such damages or if such damages could have been reasonably foreseen.

### REPRESENTATIONS AND WARRANTIES

1. OWNER represents and warrants that: (a) OWNER has the right to grant to SPONSOR the partnership and all of the benefits described in this Agreement; (b) OWNER has obtained the approvals of all third parties which are required (if any) in order for OWNER to grant the benefits under this Agreement in favor of SPONSOR; (c) the naming rights and benefits described in and granted under this Agreement comply with all applicable laws; and (d) the Advertising Materials shall be of good quality, shall conform to the requirements of this Agreement, and shall be prepared in a professional and workmanlike manner.

### XII. ADVERTISING MATERIALS AND INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

- 1. All Advertising Materials that bear SPONSOR's name and/or trademarks ("Marks") shall be subject to SPONSOR's written approval prior to use and shall be produced or procured by OWNER at OWNER's expense, except as otherwise herein provided.
- 2. SPONSOR hereby grants to OWNER, during the term of this Agreement, a nonexclusive, non-transferable, non-sublicensable right and license to use the Marks solely for the purpose of the identification and promotion of SPONSOR as set forth in this Agreement. OWNER acknowledges that SPONSOR is the owner of the Marks and all goodwill related thereto, and all use of the Marks under this Agreement and any goodwill accruing from such use will inure solely to SPONSOR's benefit. SPONSOR shall be solely responsible for enforcing its rights with respect to infringing uses of its name or Marks.

- 3. Except as expressly set forth herein, SPONSOR reserves all rights, and this Agreement does not grant any right, title or interest in or to the Marks to OWNER. OWNER agrees that it shall not use the Marks except as expressly authorized under this Agreement. In the event that OWNER should, by operation of law or otherwise, be deemed to have obtained any rights in the Marks, OWNER hereby irrevocably assigns its entire right, title and interest in and to the Marks to SPONSOR.
- 4. Upon termination of this Agreement, OWNER shall cease all use of the Approved Name and SPONSOR's name and Marks, and OWNER shall be solely responsible for all costs associated with the removal of all uses of the Approved Name and SPONSOR's name and Marks.

### XIII. NAME CHANGE

1. If SPONSOR changes its corporate name or trade name, undergoes a change in control that results in a name change or sells all or substantially all of its assets to another entity, and such entity does not continue to use the SPONSOR name, SPONSOR or its successor, as the case may be, shall promptly submit new Marks to OWNER, and the Parties shall mutually agree in writing upon corresponding changes to the Approved Name and related branding. SPONSOR or its successor will be responsible for all out of pocket costs in connection with the replacement of the Approved Name and related branding in all signage and other Advertising Materials. OWNER shall accept any such name and branding change unless it would result in a name or graphic that is inconsistent with or detrimental to the reputation of the Wood River Recreation Center or is contrary to community standards of good taste. In such event, the Parties shall negotiate in good faith to determine another Approved Name and related branding for the Wood River Recreation Center as soon as reasonably possible.

### XIV. MISCELLANEOUS

- 1. This Agreement: (a) may be amended only by a writing signed by each of the Parties; (b) may be executed in several counterparts, each of which is deemed an original but all of which constitute one and the same instrument; (c) is governed by, and will be construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois, without giving effect to any conflict of laws rules; (d) is binding upon, and will inure to the benefit of the Parties and their respective heirs, successors and permitted assigns; and (e) constitutes the sole and entire agreement of the Parties with respect to the subject matter herein, and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous understandings, agreements, representations, and warranties, both written and oral, with respect to the subject matter herein. Each Party expressly consents to the exclusive jurisdiction of the federal, state and local courts serving Madison County, IL, to govern all disputes arising out of this Agreement.
- 2. The due performance or observance by a Party of any of its obligations under this Agreement may be waived only by a writing signed by the Party against whom enforcement of such waiver is sought, and any such waiver will be effective only to the extent specifically set forth in such writing. The waiver by a Party of any breach or violation of any provision of this Agreement will not operate as, or be construed to be, a waiver of any subsequent breach or violation hereof. Any provision of this Agreement, which is prohibited or unenforceable in any jurisdiction will, as to such jurisdiction, be ineffective to the extent of such prohibition or unenforceability without invalidating the remaining portions hereof or affecting the validity or enforceability of such provision in any other jurisdiction.
- 3. The Parties shall not assign any of their rights or obligations under this Agreement without the prior written consent of the other Party.

- 4. The relationship between the Parties is that of independent contractors. Nothing contained in this Agreement creates any agency, partnership, joint venture or other form of joint enterprise, employment or fiduciary relationship between the Parties, and neither Party has authority to contract for or bind the other Party in any manner whatsoever.
- 5. All notices in connection with this Agreement shall be in writing and delivered to the principal place of business of each Party or any other address of which either Party shall notify the other Party in writing from time to time.
- 6. Should any provision of this Agreement be determined to be invalid or illegal for any reason, such invalidity or illegality shall not affect the validity or legality of any other provision, and all other provisions shall remain in full force and effect as if this Agreement had been executed with the invalid or illegal provision eliminated.

### **TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION EASEMENT**

Jack in the Box Properties, LLC, a limited liability company, organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Delaware and duly authorized to do business under the Statutes of the State of Illinois, hereinafter referred to as "GRANTOR", for and in consideration of Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$750.00), receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, hereby grants and conveys unto the City of Wood River, Illinois, a Municipal Corporation, organized and existing under the laws of the State of Illinois, its successors or assigns, herein after referred to as "GRANTEE", a temporary construction easement upon the following described tract of land:

Madison County Parcel ID Number: 19-2-08-21-12-202-019

Located at 41 E. Edwardsville Road, Wood River, Illinois and further described as shown on the attached Exhibit "A" marked as TCE and consisting of 647 square feet of area.

For the purpose of reconstruction of sidewalks and for traffic signal work in conjunction with proposed street improvements for Wood River Avenue, also known as Section 17-00048-00-RS and 18-00048-01-RS.

GRANTEE'S contractors shall not restrict public access to and from the GRANTOR'S property except for short periods of time during daytime work hours for construction activities only and only one entrance may be affected at a time. GRANTOR'S contractors shall provide prior notice to the manager of the Jack in the Box restaurant and obtain their approval to restrict any driveway and when a driveway is restricted, the contractor shall provide cones or barricades for traffic protection for the Jack in the Box customers and shall provide a traffic control flagman if site distance is restricted onto the public streets.

The right, easement and privilege granted herein shall terminate 2 years from the date of execution of this document, or on the completion of the proposed project, whichever is sooner.

GRANTEE will be responsible for restoring GRANTOR'S property following construction.




