## **ORDINANCE NO:**

ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY CODE TITLE III – ADMINISTRATION, CHAPTER 32 – CITY COUNCIL, SECTION 32.15 - MEETINGS, TO BRING SECTION 32.15(B) INTO COMPLIANCE WITH STATE LAW

WHEREAS, the City of Wood River, Madison County, Illinois (hereinafter "City"), is a non-home rule municipality duly established, existing and operating in accordance with the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code (Section 5/1-1-1 et seq. of Chapter 65 of the Illinois Compiled Statutes); and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Constitution provides that non-home rule municipalities shall have only those powers which have been specifically granted to them by State law (see Ill. Const 1970 art. VII, §7); and

WHEREAS, thus, as a non-home rule municipality, City has no authority to deviate from specific statutory provisions and mandates (see Ill. Const 1970 art. VII, §7); and

WHEREAS, Section 3.1-40-25 of Chapter 65 of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, 65 ILCS 5/3.1-40-25, requires that only the mayor or three (3) members of the city council may request a special meeting of the city council; and

WHEREAS, Illinois law further specifies that Section 3.1-40-25 applies to a city manager form of government (see 65 ILCS 5/3.1-5-5), which City has adopted; and

WHEREAS, Corporate Council has advised the City Council that Section 32.15 of City's Code of Ordinances ("City Code"), as currently enacted, is in direct conflict with 65 ILCS 5/3.1-40-25, in that Section 32.15(B) states that a special meeting of the City Council may be called at the request of only two (2) members of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, City Council has determined that it is in the best interests of public health, safety, general welfare, and economic welfare to amend Section 32.15 of the City Code in order to bring Section 32.15(B) into compliance with State law by requiring three (3) members of the City Council, or the Mayor, to request a special meeting of the City Council in order to hold a special meeting of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the Mayor and/or City Manager should be authorized and directed, on behalf of the City, to execute whatever documents are necessary to amend the City Code Section 32.15 to bring Section 32.15(B) into compliance with State law as stated herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Wood River, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are incorporated herein as findings of the City Council of the City of Wood River, Illinois.

Section 2. Title III of the City Code - Administration, Chapter 32 – City Council, Section 32.15 shall now state:

## §32.15 MEETINGS

(A) Regular meetings.

Upon a roll call vote, the following was recorded:

AYES: NAYS:

- (1) *Time*. The City Council shall hold regular meetings on the first and third Monday of each month at 7:00 p.m.; however, when the day fixed for any regular meeting of the Council falls upon a day designated by law as a legal or national holiday, such meeting shall be held at the same hour on the next succeeding day not a holiday.
- (2) Place. All regular meetings of the Council shall be held in the city hall.
- (B) Special meetings. The Mayor shall call special meetings of the City Council whenever in his or her opinion the public business may require it, or at the express written request of any three members of the Council. Whenever a special meeting shall be called, a summons or a notice in writing, signed by the Mayor, shall be served upon each member of the Council, either in person, by e-mail to the Councilmember's City e-mail address, or by notice left at his or her place of residence, stating the date and hour of the meeting and the purpose for which such meeting is called, and no business shall be transacted thereat, except such as is stated in the notice.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall be known as Ordinance No: \_\_\_\_\_ and shall be effective upon adoption with implementation date of March 6, 2025.
